

Clearing IN/OUT Puerto Princesa City, Philippines

Requirements:

- *Complete papers of sailboat/yacht (registration and proof of ownership)
- *Photos of yacht (on the water: port, starboard, bow, stern)
- *Crew list (name, nationality, passport number)
- *Passports (copy of information page)
- *Boat stamp (if available)
- *Port Clearance from the last port of call..
- *Proof of Appointment as Master if Owner is not aboard

1. Send NOTICE OF ARRIVAL. Attach the requirements; send by email 3 days advance or earlier to the following offices:

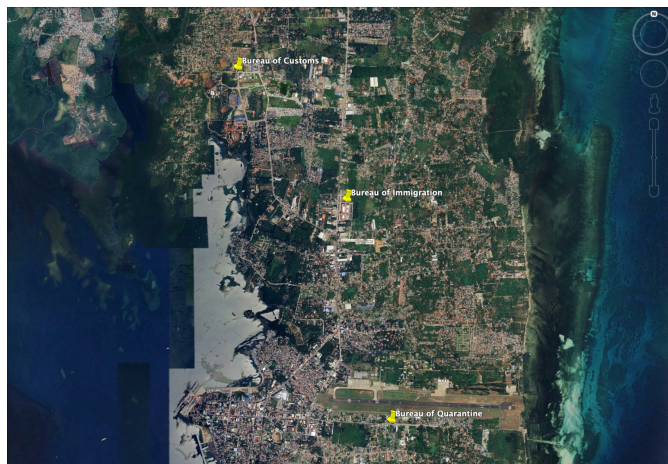

Take note of replies and any instructions that they may contain.

2. Depending on whether you have received a reply telling you that you should stay aboard for inspection or to visit respective offices, this location image may assist you if you need to visit offices.



If you are anchored / moored off Abanico Yacht Club then they can assist you with finding transport that will take you to your CIQ destinations. Best advice is to visit the offices in the sequence shown above – in particular, Immigration likes to know you have completed C and Q before visiting them.

Please note: if expecting to arrive on a weekend many Government offices do not work on Sundays, and may not work on Saturdays, depending on whether they are operating as “essential services”, so you may have to stay aboard until Monday.
